RADIO

- ✧ 103.3 Moose-FM is the only radio station located in the District of Parry Sound. With studios in the Town of Parry Sound, CKLP-FM services both the district of Parry Sound and Muskoka.
 - Broadcasting with a power of 50,000 watts, at 103.3 MHZ on the dial.
 - 103.3 Moose-FM is heard from Barrie to Sudbury - North Bay with an audience consisting of resident and visitor alike.

TELEVISION

- ✧ The Town of Parry Sound and surrounding areas (12 km) receive signals from four local television stations (Barrie, Toronto, Kitchener and Sudbury), in addition to numerous stations off satellites. Cable television is available to the Town of Parry Sound and surrounding area.
